
## **The Second Coming of Christ**



... I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

~ John 14:3

 The Second Coming of Jesus Christ is a prevailing biblical theme in the New Testament.

 It is alluded to more than 300 times in the New Testament and is referenced 8x more than the Lord's initial coming. • It is relevant to each and every person living because the Lord's second coming will mark the end of time, the judgment, and the moment when Christians will enter their eternal reward (Hebrews 9:27).

 We will see this prophesied in the Old Testament and Affirmed in the New Testament.  We will see this affirmed with real tangible features and examine the events associated with the Second Coming of Jesus Christ.

 The second coming is assured, and it is our task this morning to demonstrate this from the Word of God...

## **Prophesied in The Old Testament**



The Resurrection is a New Testament Theme.
 The New Testament writers often spoke of the gospel and the things concerning Jesus Christ as being revealed to them as "The Mystery"

 What they are saying is that The Old Testament writers, though inspired, were not fully understanding of the things they wrote concerning Christ. To me, who am less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, and to make all see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who created all things through Jesus Christ.

~ Ephesians 3:8-9

... I became a minister according to the stewardship from God which was given to me for you, to fulfill the word of God, he mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints.

~ Colossians 1:25-26

Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace that would come to you, searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow. To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, (Continued)

but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things which angels desire to look into.

~ 1 Peter 1:10-12

 One might expect this theme of the Resurrection to therefore be an entirely New Testament theme...

 However, scattered throughout the New Testament are theses prophetic utterances that Peter speaks of, these little tidbits nestled in Old Testament Prophecy that confirm Peter and Paul's testimony.

#### - The Book of Job

 The Book of Job may be the oldest recorded inspired story in the entire Bible.

 Job believed that there would be a time of vindication by his redeemer after his flesh was disintegrated. For I know that my Redeemer lives, And He shall stand at last on the earth; And after my skin is destroyed, this I know, That in my flesh I shall see God, Whom I shall see for myself, And my eyes shall behold, and not another. How my heart yearns within me!

~ Job 19:25-27

#### - King David

David foretold of ultimate retribution upon God's enemies.

The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool."

~ Psalm 110:1

The Prophet Isaiah

- Isaiah Spoke of a time when every knee would, and every tongue would confess God.

- This verse was even repeated by the Apostle Paul.

I have sworn by Myself; The word has gone out of My mouth *in* righteousness, And shall not return, That to Me every knee shall bow, Every tongue shall take an oath.

~ Isaiah 45:23 (Romans 14:11)


#### The Book of Daniel

- Daniel prophesied of a future bodily resurrection, which is associated with the Lord's coming (1 Corinthians 15:50-52; I Thessalonians 4:13-18).

 This predated Christ's first mention of it by nearly six hundred years. And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt. And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

~ Daniel 12:2-3

# **Affirmed in the New Testament**



- Jesus Affirmed it Himself (Matthew 24:37-44)
- "I Will Come Again" (John 14:3)
- Angels declared he would come again (Acts 1:11)
- Paul declares the return of Jesus Christ and what it means to us (1 Thessalonians 4:13-5:1; 1 Corinthians 15:23)
- James the Brother of Jesus (James 5:7)

## **Features of the Second Coming**



 His Return is Certain, and is described as a definite day:

that you were enriched in everything by Him in all utterance and all knowledge, even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you, so that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ, who will also confirm you to the end, that you may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.

~ 1 Corinthians 1:5-8

 Although it is Certain, when this Day will come is never revealed.

 The Second Coming Will Be Literal and Personal

#### For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven

with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

The Second Coming Will Be Visible

- He Is To Be Revealed (2 Thessalonians 1:7)

- He will be manifested (1 John 2:28)

- This involves an actual appearance ...

That you keep *this* commandment without spot, blameless until our <u>Lord Jesus Christ's</u>

<u>appearing</u>, which <u>He will manifest in His own</u>

<u>time</u>, *He who is* the blessed and only

Potentate, the King of kings and Lord of lords.

### His Return Will Be Final, Complete, The End

But each one in his own order: Christ the first fruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming. Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power.

#### The Judgment
